Sunday 20th May 2018 Supplementary regulations

1. JURISDICTION

This event is a Gravel Rallysprint promoted by the **Hamilton Car Club** and will take place on **Sunday 20th May 2018** in the Otorohanga/Pirongia area. This is a Club Sport status event.

The event will run under the Motorsport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix 3, Schedule RS being the Standing Regulations Governing all Rallysprint Events and Appendix 2, Schedule A - Driver Safety and Vehicle Requirements, and any other amendments thereto.

3. THE EVENT:

Pirongia West Road, Ngutunui, Otorohanga, Sunday 20th May 2018 Venue: Length:

9 kilometres - Gravel Surface. Touring TBA. Possibly 20km public

roads.

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Reece Run: At 9.00am at Pirongia West Road

Drivers Briefing: 8.30am - All drivers must attend drivers briefing at the service park. A

roll call will be taken.

Each car will complete a Recce Run and four timed runs. Elimination style results as per normal Northern Rallysprint format will apply; an extra runoff will be used for the top two cars in each class to determine the winner.

If due to force majeure, the runs cannot be completed the appointed Motorsport NZ Steward, after consultation with the Clerk of the Course has the authority to approve the reduction of the minimum requirements. The format that will apply if this happens will be advised prior to the event commencing at drivers briefing.

Hamilton Car Club reserves the right to cancel the event in the event of adverse weather.

4. ENTRIES

Closing: Normal entries will close at 5.00pm, Wednesday 16th May, 2018.

Late Entries: Late entries will close at 5:00pm Saturday 19th May 2018 by end of

documentation.

Entries to be made on the correct form and to be deemed valid must be complete in all details and accompanied by the appropriate fees.

Organisers reserve the right refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code.

The maximum Number of starters will be 60. Any additional entries received after the normal closing date, will be included at the organisers discretion.

In the event of timing equipment failure, or as result of instruction from the Clerk of the Course, a competitor will be allowed a Rerun. Reruns will not be permitted if the timing equipment is displaced or damaged by that competitor.

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Dual Driver will be allowed, but please note there will be little to no service time between runs for dual drivers. Please indicate on your entry form if you are a dual driver.

Acceptance of entry:

Acceptance of entry will be at the absolute discretion of the organisers. Where more entries than the maximum are received up to the closing of normal entries, late entries will be on a first come first serve basis.

5. COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS:

In signing the entry form competitors (entrant and drivers) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ Inc. National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules, in particular the National Sporting Code articles pertaining to protests and competitors obligations.

- All vehicles must comply with Clause 5 of Schedule 3 Appendix RS
- Rally tyres are permitted.
- Drivers and passengers shall wear safety Apparel as specified in the driver safety regulations contained in Appendix Two Schedule A.
- Drivers must be aware that all passengers must be briefed on basic event safety procedures, how to correctly wear and subsequently uncouple the safety harness.
- All passengers must sign the passenger indemnity and declaration form prior to their participation.
- The start line will check if the passenger has signed the indemnity and declaration form before allowing the vehicle to start, if the passenger is found not to have signed said indemnity and declaration form then the vehicle will be removed from the start line and this may cause the driver to forfeit this run.
- Minimum age of any passengers is 12 years old.
- Any passengers under 16 years of age must complete a passenger indemnity form at documentation signed by a parent or legal guardian (not just the person taking care of the underage passenger for the day)
- Driver must hold an M Grade Licence or higher.
- Current Car Club Membership
- If the entrant is other than the driver, an entrant's licence is required in the name of the entrant.
- All cars must have current wof and reg

All driver(s) must attend the drivers briefing at 8.30am Sunday 20th May 2018 at the venue.

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NOTE: MNZ new clothing and apparel regulations will be in effect for this event. Schedule A 4.3.2 Protective clothing:

i.e. minimum requirements are single layer overall suit with cotton or wool underwear, short sleeves, OK. Cotton or wool socks. Balaclava for driver and passenger. Gloves for driver, optional for passenger. Leather footwear. NO runners, sneakers unless leather. This will be enforced at this rallysprint.

13. EVENT DIRECTIONS

Competitor's access to the venue (Service Park) is via Highway 39 from Hamilton travelling to Pirongia. From Pirongia traveling south 9.4kms, turn right into Ngutunui Rd (sign posted Kawhia).

If coming from Otorohanga they will head north along Highway 39 for approx. 15km before turning left into Ngutunui Rd .

Head along Ngutunui Rd for approx. 3.8kms km, turn right into Pekanui Rd (Ngutunui School) on your left. Travel 9kms up the hill to the top where the service area will be signposted.

14. GENERAL

FOOD:

The Ngutunui School PTA is selling food for competitors on the day

Please support them as they really support us for our two events we run in their area

Alcohol is **NOT** permitted to be consumed by competitors or crew until after competition has been completed.

NO Dogs Allowed at the venue.

Please collect all rubbish and tidy up around you before you leave each day.

All competitors to supply and service on a ground sheet

Servicing is only permitted in the designated service park.

All competitors will be required to pay for any fencing or property damage costs incurred within seven days of the fencing account being presented. Where multiple competitors go

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off in the same section of fence, repair costs will be divided evenly between the parties involved.

On release of these regulations any competitor seen travelling the course before the start of the event will be excluded from the event and fined in accordance with Motorsport NZ manual No.35

Starting Order:

Competitors must start in numerical order to be allowed to complete each run. No allowance will be made for competitors that fail to present themselves in the correct starting order unless arranged with the clerk of course.

Ensure you are using the correct fuel type and refuelling procedure as per National sporting code.

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
